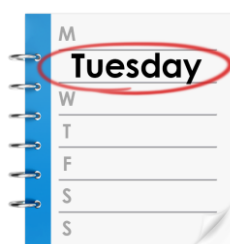


Governing Body Meeting 24th September 2019 Easy Read Agenda

The notes (minutes) of what happened at the last meeting will be checked.



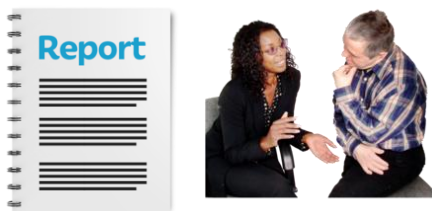
Members of the public can ask questions about what is happening.



Dr Dalton will tell people what has happened in June, July and August.



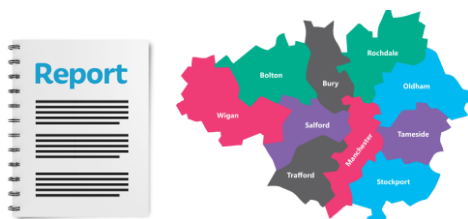
Professor Harris, our top manager, will tell people what has happened in July and August.

There is a report on what we did last year, including how we managed our money.



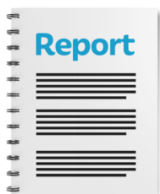
There is a report on how well local NHS services are doing.
