AWARD 1: PATIENT AMBASSADOR OF THE YEAR

JUDGING CRITERIA:

Improved Quality:

- An explanation of how their contributions have led to an improvement in a practice or a service

Engagement:

- Evidence of how they engage with other patients to seek further engagement and encourage wider patient involvement
- Evidence of how they engage with the CCG and other organisations to create change

Outcomes:

- Evidence that this has helped you to deliver services that will lead to better patient outcomes

Integration:

- An explanation of how the patient encourages you to look past organisational barriers to improve services for patients

- Evidence of how wider patients or members of the community were involved in the PPG project

Outcomes:

- Evidence that this will lead to better patient outcomes

Integration:

- An explanation of how the project involved wider stakeholders / services

- An explanation of how the practice or individual goes above and beyond to work with and involve the PPG

Improved Quality:

- An explanation of how the relationship between the practice and PPG improves services

Engagement:

- Evidence of how the practice or individual engages with the PPG and wider practice patients

Outcomes:

- Evidence that the relationship between the practice or individual and the PPG leads to better patient outcomes

Integration:

- An explanation of how the practice or individual involves wider stakeholders / services in the work of the PPG
