Y02378 Dr Alistair - Golborne site PPG – 17/09/2015

- Flexibility between two sites is helpful to them, it means they may be able to be seen quicker or by a certain GP
- They were not aware that the contract was time limited, and this is a worry in terms of stability – one member of the group is poorly and doesn't want uncertainty about who his GP will be and the time limited nature of the contract may make him consider moving practice
- Group asked if the CCG has a criteria for decision making whether to re-procedure or disperse the list
- Currently very happy with practice services. It is a training practice, but as well as training medical staff there is investment in training for the admin staff and they feel this is reflected in standards
- Report to not feel particularly well supported in Golborne amenities wise, so it is important to them to have a good GP surgery
- Question was raised about whether CCG pays the estates costs for APMS practices?
- If it was to go through re-procurement it would be a concern to patients if organisations outside the UK could bid for them
